

Major Milestones in the Organizational History of the National Taxation Bureau of the Northern Area, Ministry of Finance

Year	Major Events
1992	The National Tax Administration of Northern Taiwan Province, Ministry of Finance, is established on July 1, 1992.
1997	The Kinmen Service Station and the Second Office are established to handle national tax collection operations in the Kinmen and Matsu regions.
1998	The Second Office of the Kinmen Service Station is restructured as the Matsu Service Station.
2003	Starting from January 1, 2003, the collection of business tax, which had previously been entrusted by the regional National Taxation Bureaus of the Ministry of Finance to the tax collection offices of municipalities and county (city) governments, is reverted to the National Taxation Bureaus for direct administration.
2008	The Kinmen Service Station is reorganized into the Kinmen Office.
2008	Due to the rapid industrial and commercial development in the Xizhi area, a significant increase in business volume, the establishment of the Xike Science Park, and the expansion of the Far Eastern Technology Park, the Ruifang Taxation Office is relocated to Xizhi City and renamed the Xizhi Taxation Office. The original site of the Ruifang Taxation Office is renamed the Ruifang Service Station under the Xizhi Office.
2010	In line with the reorganization of Taipei County into New Taipei City, the Taipei County Branch is renamed the Banqiao Branch.
2013	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The official name of the National Tax Administration of Northern Taiwan Province, Ministry of Finance, is changed to the “National Taxation Bureau of the Northern Area, Ministry of Finance.” 2. The Ruifang Service Station, previously under the jurisdiction of the Xizhi Office, is restructured as an independent unit.
2023	The organizational structure of the Bureau is revised, consolidating the ten “Sections” at the headquarters level into six “Divisions.”
2024	In response to the rapid growth of national tax operations in the Taoyuan area, the Luzhu Office is newly established. Additionally, the operations of the Qidu Office are integrated into the Keelung Branch.
